Procedure for Admission to FYJC

Submit Admission form ONLINE

1. The Hard Copy of applications for admission should be submitted within 7 days from the announcement of S.S.C. results of March 2022 examination.
2. The applications should clearly indicate the groups in priority for which admission is sought.
3. The applications according to priority preference will be scrutinised by the admission committee for each Faculty and the list will be put up on the notice-board.
4. The applications whose names appear in the list should submit in given time the following documents in original to get admission.
 - a) School Leaving Certificate (TC) from the last school or college attended.
 - b) Marks Sheet of the last examination passed.
 - c) Caste Certificate in original for SC/ST/NT/VJNT/OBC candidates.
 - d) Two Xerox copies of T.C. Mark sheet and Caste Certificate and Aadhar Card.
 - e) Two passport size coloured photographs.
5. Students who have passed S.S.C. from other than Maharashtra Boards should obtain eligibility certificate from the Maharashtra Board and should submit Migration Certificate at the time of admission.
6. Separate applications for different Faculties/Groups will have to be submitted, if the applicant so desires.
7. Students belonging to reserved category should produce Caste Verification Certificate at the time of admission.
8. Students who will be admitted in non grant classes in Science and Commerce faculties will have to pay fee specified by the management.
9. Admission will be finalised only after the payment of necessary fees only.
10. Once admitted, no change of Faculty, subject or Medium will be permitted.
11. No student will be admitted on the basis of duplicate TC. or true copy.
12. The students who have passed prior to March 2022 Examination, will have to submit affidavit for gap.
13. Students seeking admission in Hindi linguistics minority category should submit an affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper in prescribed proforma.



Admission to Degree College

Submit Admission forms ONLINE

1. Submit the hard copy of admission form along with xerox copies of documents.
2. Admission will be according to Merit List.
3. Admission for reservation quota will be according to Govt. norms.
4. For Admission against reserve category must produce valid case certificate.
5. Students who are eligible for admission to Sem III & V of B.A., B.Com. & B.Sc., should finalise, their admissions within one week from the announcement of the results of Part I or Part II. Late fees of Rs. 25/- will be charged after that.
6. Students joining P.G. classes in Arts and Commerce faculties will note that the medium of instruction will be English, but they may offer English or Marathi or Hindi as medium for examination.
7. Students from other Universities should submit Eligibility Certificate from Nagpur University before taking admission.
8. Students will not be admitted after the last date of admission, prescribed by the University.
9. All applications for admission should be accompanied by
 - a) T.C. from the last institution attended.
 - b) Marks Sheet of last Examination Passed.
 - c) Caste Certificate in original for SC/ST/VJNT/OBC candidates.
 - d) Two xerox copies of T.C., Marks Sheet, Caste Certificate & Aadhar Card.
 - e) Two passport size coloured photographs.
10. Students seeking admission in Hindi linguistics minority category should submit an affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper in prescribed proforma.

SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Students who belong to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Nomadic Tribes and Vimukta Jati and OBC should submit their applications for scholarships within 15 days from the date of admission, along with Caste Certificate (in original and two xerox copies) and Marks Sheet of the qualifying examination (original and xerox copy) and affidavits in case of gaps, if any.
2. Students belonging to Economically Backward Classes are eligible for scholarships if they have secured 50% marks. They should submit their applications with income Certificates in the prescribed form within 15 days from the date of admission (Junior College only)
3. National Merit Scholarship students who are eligible for the categories mentioned above, should contact the Office Staff immediately after admission for necessary details.
4. Open Merit Scholarship (State Government) Students who have secured 60% or more marks in S.S.C. Examination, should submit their applications to the office within the prescribed time limit.
5. Physically Handicapped students should contact the office for scholarship forms.
6. Students seeking fee concessions under the categories of E.B.C. Primary School Teacher's children, Secondary School Teacher's Children and wards of Military Personnel, should submit their applications complete in all respects within Ten days after Admission. (E.B.C. concession will be approved only after Govt. Sanction.)



RULES

1) ATTENDANCE:

A student who does not attend 75% of the lectures or practical in each subject offered by him/her is liable to be detained and shall not be permitted to appear in the college promotion or Board or University examination. Fine will be imposed on the irregular students.

2) DRESSCODE: (Junior College)

Students of Junior College (FYJC and SYJC) will have to observe dress code while attending college. The Dress code to be followed is as follows:

Boys': Blue Brown Checks Shirt with full Sleeve and college logo, Dark Raymond blue trouser, Black shoes with white socks.

Girls': Blue Brown Checks Kurta with college logo, Dark Blue Salwar, Black-blue Dupatta, Black shoes with white socks.

Students of Junior College will not be allowed to attend classes in the college without uniform.

DRESSCODE: (Senior College)

All the students of UG & PG in Arts, Commerce and Science faculty will have to observe the following dress code.

Boys : Blue Pin lining shirt with full sleeve with college logo and cross blue trouser; Black shoes and white socks.

Girls : Blue Pin lining kurta or Blue Pin Lining Shirt-with full sleeve and cross blue trouser; with college logo blue salwar and blue dupatta, Black shoes, white socks

*** No students shall be allowed to enter college premises without college uniform.**

3) DISCIPLINE:

Student who is found to be disturbing the classes or indulging in indisciplinary activities is liable to fine or expulsion or restriction from the college, The Principal is the final authority in all matters of discipline.

4) LABORATORIES:

No student is permitted to enter any laboratory when he does not have practical class there. Strict carefulness in handling the equipments must be maintained while in the laboratory. Science students should maintain their practical records up to date and get them verified by their lecturers.

5) IDENTITYCARD:

Every student must carry his/her Identity Card duly signed by the Principal or the Vice-Principal whenever he is in the college premises. Student must carry his/her Identity Card in college. Only his/her parents or guardian would be allowed when required, outsiders shall not accompany him/her, otherwise it could amount to cancellation of his/her admission/heavy punishment. No student is permitted to bring to the college premises any outsider except his parent of guardian. Duplicate Identity Card will only be issued on payment of fine or Rs. 100/-

ANNUAL PROMOTION EXAMINATIONS FOR F.Y.J.C.

No Student will be promoted to SYJC (XII Std.) unless he/she is declared passed at the XI Std. examination as per rules.

LIBRARY:

1. Every student of Degree and Junior College classes will be issued 3 borrower cards against which he/she may borrow 2 Text books and 1 general reading book. These books should be returned to the library within one week.
2. No student should permit any other person to use the borrower cards issued in his name.
3. Degree students may also avail of the Book Bank Scheme. They have to deposit the cost of the books borrowed and return them within 3 days after final examination or earlier. The cost deposited will be refunded after necessary deduction.
4. The student should ensure that the book borrowed by him/her is not damaged when he borrows it if is found that he returns a book in a damaged condition, the cost with a fine of Rs. 5/- will be charged from him.
5. The Librarian will refuse to receive any book returned in a damaged condition or with any matter written on the pages. The cost of such books with fine will be recovered from the student.
