



ANTI RAGGING CELL



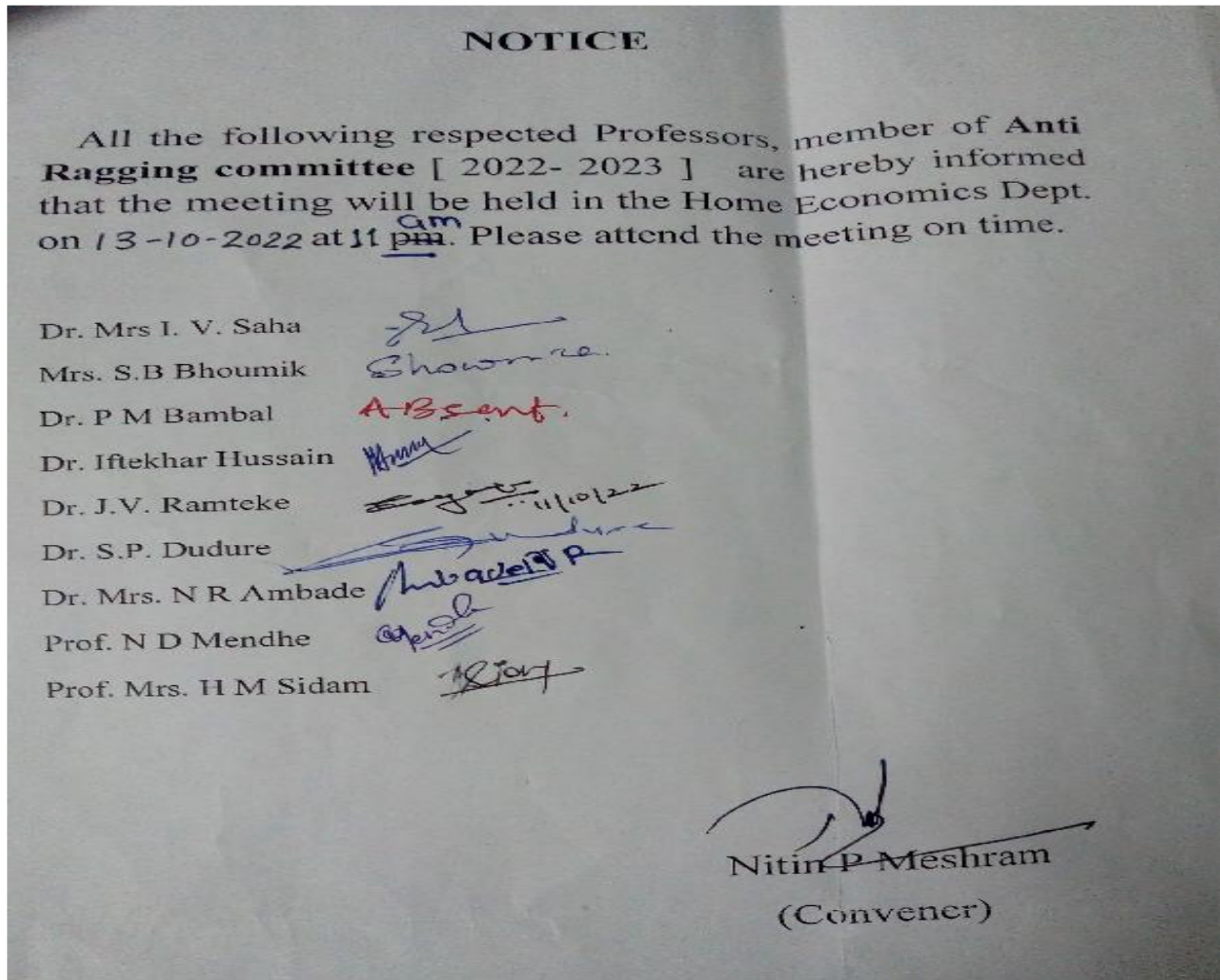
Anti ragging cell
