

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereafter referred to 'MOU') is made and executed at Nagpur on 23rd May, 2019

BETWEEN

M/s Virohan Institute of Health & Management Sciences, (A Unit of M/s Oxys Learning Private Limited in partnership with Satya Saluja Literacy Foundation) duly registered with the office of Sub-Registrar, Nagpur, having its Office at 192, Bhamti Parsodi Rd., Trimurti Nagar Square , Ring Rd., Trimurti Nagar, Nagpur-440022(hereinafter referred to as the "**FIRST PARTY**") of the **ONE PART**

AND

Seth Kesarimal Porwal College , Kamptee affiliated with Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University (RTMNU), Nagpur, recognized by State Government under University Grants Commission of India (UGC) having its address at Nr. Dragan Palace ,Kamptee (hereinafter referred to as the "**SECOND PARTY**") of the **OTHER PART**.

The terms "**FIRST PARTY**" and "**SECOND PARTY**" shall, unless repugnant to the context or the meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include their respective nominees, heirs, successors and permitted assigns.

The First Party and the Second Party shall hereinafter collectively be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

WHEREAS the First Party is engaged in the business of delivering skill building, training, academics and research Programs with the aim of creating skilled professionals and enhancing the leadership and delivery capabilities of existing professionals & other skilled manpower in all levels.

AND WHEREAS the Second Party is an Education Institution under Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University (RTMNU) and accredited by NAAC with in the field of education.

AND WHEREAS the First Party wishes to partner with Second Party in order to train students of the Second Party in various training programs to provide placement support.

AND WHEREAS for the said purpose the First Party and the Second Party have agreed on the following terms and conditions which they now wish to record in writing as mentioned hereinafter in this MOU.

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

I. Scope of Partnership

1. The Second Party shall provide the First Party with access and reach to the students ("**Students**") to be trained by the First Party under the various programs ("**Training Program**"). The Second Party expressly agrees that First Party will be allowed to interact with students, conduct Seminars, promote programs, put up Banners & Posters inside College premises, circulate flyers, participate in college events from time to time.

2. The First Party shall only offer the Students various Training Programs run by itself (refer Annexure – A). The training period of include the following:
 - a. theory classes at the premises of the First Party; and
 - b. a period of internship for a minimum of 3-6 months.

It is hereby clarified that the obligation of the First Party shall be limited to the extent of providing classroom training to the Students under sub-clauses (a) & (b) above. The First Party shall provide support in placement/ employment of the Students but shall not be held responsible for the same since it does not guarantee employment.

3. It is hereby expressly acknowledged by the Parties that the Second Party shall not have any rights to make any representations to the Students or to third parties on behalf of the First Party except with express prior written consent of the First Party.

II. Consideration

The First Party shall pay incentives of Rs. 2000/- for certification and Rs. 3000/- for Diploma program per student admission.

This MOU is valid for 36 calendar months from date of signing .

III. Confidential Information

1. The First Party (“**Disclosing Party**”) during the term of the MOU may disclose to the Second Party (“**Recipient**”) certain proprietary and confidential information. The Recipient undertake that it and its personnel shall not, during the period of this MOU or at any time thereafter, use or disclose to anyone, any information relating to the business or affairs or intellectual rights of the Disclosing Party or its affiliates which the Recipient may be exposed to or may receive during the course of the MOU and the Recipient shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Disclosing Party from all losses or damage arising from any breach of this undertaking.
2. For the purposes of this Agreement, “**Confidential Information**” refers to any and all data and information contained in any medium of expression, including but not limited to business figures, techniques and technologies, modules, strategic plans and budgets, investments, customers and sales, objectives, business and market strategies, proposed and ongoing commercial transactions, customer lists, unpublished price sensitive information and such other commercial, financial and technical information and documentation, trade secrets, information relating to its trademarks, copyrights, etc., and all other relevant information as may be disclosed by Disclosing Party to the Recipient pursuant to this Agreement irrespective of whether it is marked or identified as confidential.
3. The Recipient agrees to protect the Disclosing Party’s Information to the same extent that it protects its own confidential information of a similar nature and shall take all reasonable precautions to prevent any unauthorized disclosure of Confidential Information to third parties. The Recipient may disclose the Disclosing Party’s Confidential Information to its directors, officers, employees (“**Representatives**”) on a need to know basis and to the extent necessary for the purpose of this MOU provided that such Representatives are bound by confidentiality obligations similar to the obligation under this MOU.
4. Neither party shall be bound by any obligations under this clause with respect to the Confidential information of the other Party, or any part thereof, which:
 - i. Was known to the Parties prior to disclosure;

- ii. Was lawfully in the public domain prior to the disclosure, or becomes publicly available other than through a breach of the confidentiality obligations of the Recipient as specified under this Clause;
 - iii. Was disclosed to the Recipient by a third party, provided that such third party is not in breach of any confidentiality obligation in respect of such information; or
 - iv. Is independently developed by the Recipient without any reference to the Confidential Information disclosed by the Disclosing Party.
5. The Second Party shall ensure compliance with all applicable data protection regulations in its collection, use and sharing of personal information of the Students.

IV. Indemnification

The Second Party hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the First Party harmless against all claims, liabilities, damages, suits, proceedings, cost and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fee) arising as a consequence of any third party claims arising due to (i) any act or omission of the Second Party; (ii) fraud or misrepresentation by the Second Party; (iii) negligence or willful misconduct of the Second Party; (iv) breach of representations and warranties; (v) infringement of intellectual property rights; and (vi) violation of applicable laws by the Second Party.

V. Intellectual Property Rights

Nothing in this MOU grants the right or license to the Second Party to use the name, branding, trademark or logo of the First Party or any content, training material, course material or any other documentation owned by the First Party ("IPR") for any purpose whatsoever. The Second Party may use the IPR for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this MOU subject to a prior written consent from the First Party. The Second Party shall not, either directly or through a third party, challenge the rights or ownership of the First Party on IPR.

VI. Representations and Warranties

Each Party represents and warrants to the other Party that: (i) such Party has the full right, power and authority to enter into this MOU and to perform the acts required of it hereunder; (ii) the execution of this MOU by such Party, and the performance by such Party of its obligations and duties hereunder, do not and will not violate any agreement to which such Party is a party or by which it is otherwise bound; (iii) when executed and delivered by such Party, this MOU will constitute the legal, valid and binding obligation of such Party, enforceable against such Party in accordance with its terms. (iv) it shall comply with applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits and certificates and payment of taxes where required.

The Second Party warrants that the existence of this MoU is within the prescribed guidelines and policy as allowed by its various authorities such as RTMNU, NAAC, UGC etc.

VII. Miscellaneous

If any provision of this MOU is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that provision will be limited or eliminated to the minimum extent necessary so that this MOU will otherwise remain in full force and effect and enforceable. This MOU is not assignable, transferable or sub licensable by the Second Party except with the First Party's prior written consent. This MOU is the complete and exclusive statement of the mutual understanding of the Parties and supersedes and cancels all previous written and oral agreements, communications and other understandings relating to the subject matter of this MOU, and that all waivers and modifications must be in a writing signed by both Parties, except as otherwise provided herein.

No agency, partnership, joint venture, or employment is created as a result of this MOU and the Second Party does not have any authority of any kind to bind the First Party in any respect whatsoever. In any action or proceeding to enforce rights under this MOU, the prevailing Party will be entitled to recover costs and attorneys' fees. All notices will be in writing and will be deemed to have been duly given when received, if personally delivered; when receipt is electronically confirmed, if transmitted by facsimile or email; the day after it is sent, if sent for next day delivery by recognized overnight delivery service; and upon receipt, if sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt reques





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
REPORT
